Producer's description

The Mack, 2377RG-26 Series, pilot valve controlled, solenoid actuation, single diaphragm deluge valves are based around a single diaphragm automatic control valve (SDCV) manufactured in epoxy coated ductile iron with roll groove end connections.

This equipment has a single moving component which is a cylindrical diaphragm; by applying pressure on the cover chamber, the diaphragm seals drip tight on its seat by realizing this pressure. The line pressure lifts the diaphragm allowing the valve to open fully. The valve is modulated to a control point by controlling the flow rate at which the water pressure fills and empties the diaphragm chamber

This equipment is used as an electronically activated deluge valve. A signal provided to the solenoid opens the pilot solenoid, this allows the diaphragm chamber to empty and the valve opens. When signalled by the fire control panel the solenoid de-energizes and the valve shuts off drip tight. If required, a manual by-pass can be fitted, via a lockable ball valve, to allow the valve to be opened for testing purposes.

Technical specification
